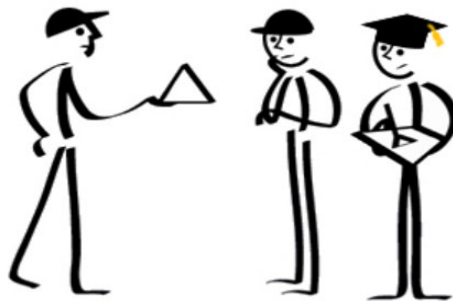
Content

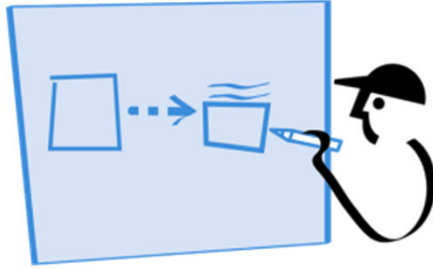
What are key questions to cause more discovery around Academic and Industry collaborative value in advancing Lean?:

5. What role does the collaborative effort of industry and professional organizations play in Lean research and case study development in the academic setting?
6. How can Case Studies from industry and AI play a role to advance Lean knowledge and skill with adult learners?
